RC DRILLING UNDERWAY AT CONTESSA

- RC drill program to test a strong induced polarisation (IP) anomaly adjacent to significant supergene gold drill hits now underway.
- Up to 1,000m of drilling to a depth of 200 metres planned to test the 150m long IP anomaly.
- Assay results expected to be returned by the end of July.




Figure 1 Location Plan - Contessa prospect, Ned's Creek Project

West Australian gold explorer Lodestar Minerals Limited (ASX:LSR, "Lodestar" or "the Company") advises that RC drilling has commenced at the Contessa gold prospect within the Company's 100%-owned Ned's Creek project (see Figure 1). The Ned's Creek project tenements are located 170 km north of Meekatharra, Western Australia.

The RC drilling is designed to test the source of a recently identified strong induced polarisation (IP) geophysical anomaly¹. The anomaly is located within a large altered diorite body where Lodestar's previous RC drilling has intersected sporadic intervals of +1g/t gold associated with wide zones of pyritic alteration² in fresh rock.

On the current schedule, first assay results from the drill program are expected to be returned by the end of July.
